Why Araya Tuition

Araya gives young people structured after-school study, homework support, mentoring and community connection. The program is built around confidence, discipline, purpose and practical support for families.

02

Program Timetable

Children's Class: Years 1-5, 3:30pm - 5:00pm. Junior Class: Years 6-9, 4:00pm - 5:30pm. Senior Class: Years 10-12, 5:45pm - 7:15pm. Classes run Monday and Wednesday or Tuesday and Thursday.

03

Free IXL Access

Every enrolled student receives IXL access for maths, English and science practice. Tutors may use IXL to reinforce class learning, identify gaps and encourage steady practice at home.

04

Attendance

Students are expected to arrive on time, sign in, participate respectfully and remain for the full session unless a parent or carer has made prior arrangements with Araya.

05

Drop Off and Pick Up

Parents and carers remain responsible for safe arrival and collection. Araya records attendance and follows approved collection arrangements to help keep students safe.

06

Risk Management

Araya reviews program activities, venues, supervision and student needs so hazards can be identified, reduced and followed up appropriately.

07

Child Safety and Compliance

Araya expects child-safe conduct from staff and volunteers, maintains working-with-children compliance, and responds promptly to child safety concerns or disclosures.
