

Araya Volunteer Pack

For tutors, activity helpers, drivers, supervisors, mentors and community members who want to support children safely and consistently.

Role	Examples
Teaching	Homework help, reading, maths, English, assignments and study routines.
Transport	Approved pick up, drop off or activity travel support.
Activities	Sport, arts, leadership, wellbeing, cultural or life-skills sessions.
Mentoring	Career stories, study pathways, leadership, discipline and resilience.

Volunteer roles

Volunteers may support teaching and homework help, reading practice, activity supervision, transport assistance, sport and wellbeing activities, creative workshops, administration, event support or mentoring.

Teacher and tutor volunteers

Tutors help students settle into study, complete homework, practise maths and English, read, revise, organise assignments and build routines. Patience, clarity and consistency matter more than perfection.

Drivers and activity supervisors

Transport and supervision volunteers help students participate in approved activities safely. Clear communication, punctuality and child-safe practice are essential.

Activity creators

Activity volunteers can help design sport, culture, arts, leadership, wellbeing, life-skills or enrichment sessions that give students healthy experiences beyond the classroom.

Mentors

Mentors share stories, skills and pathways that help students imagine a future with discipline, resilience and hope. This can be a one-off talk, a workshop, or ongoing support if approved.

Screening and expectations

Volunteers must follow Araya child safety, privacy, supervision and reporting procedures. Blue Card or exemption requirements will be confirmed before child-related work begins.
