



Website Terms and Conditions

Current as at 30 August 2026. These terms govern use of the Araya Tuition website, online forms, learning access and account features.

1. Acceptance of Terms

By accessing the Araya Tuition website, submitting a form, creating or using an account, downloading materials, making a payment, donating or otherwise using Araya's online services, the user agrees to these Terms and Conditions. If the user is under 18, a parent or guardian is responsible for the user's access and conduct.

2. Website Information

Website content is provided for general information about Araya Tuition's programs, enrolment, policies, fees, timetables, safety practices and community activities. Araya may update, correct, suspend or remove website content at any time.

While Araya seeks to keep website information accurate and current, it does not warrant that all content will be complete, error-free, uninterrupted or suitable for a user's particular purpose.

3. User Conduct

Users must not misuse the website, interfere with security, attempt unauthorised access, upload malicious code, submit false or misleading information, infringe another person's rights, harass staff or students, or use the website for unlawful, harmful or abusive purposes.

Araya may restrict, suspend or terminate access to any website, portal, account or service where it reasonably considers that a user has breached these terms, created a safety risk, misused confidential information or acted unlawfully.

4. Accounts and Portal Access

Parent, student, teacher and admin accounts are provided for authorised users only. Login credentials, one-time codes and account access must be kept confidential and must not be shared except as expressly authorised by Araya.

Araya may audit, suspend, reset or remove account access where necessary to protect students, families, staff, data, payment records, compliance records or the integrity of the program.

5. Payments, Donations and Third-Party Providers

Where payments or donations are accepted online, they may be processed by third-party payment providers. Araya is not responsible for external provider outages, banking delays, card issuer decisions or third-party terms, except to the extent required by law.

Users must ensure payment details and billing information are accurate. Donations and sponsorships are separate from tuition fees unless Araya confirms otherwise in writing.

6. Intellectual Property

Unless otherwise stated, all website content, policy documents, forms, program materials, branding, layout, images, text, downloads and resources are owned by or licensed to Araya Tuition and are protected by copyright, trade mark and other intellectual property laws.
